

# Acknowledging your funding from Arts Council of Wales

There are a number of logos that should be displayed on your publications and publicity material to acknowledge your funding from Arts Council of Wales. The exact logos to be used will depend on the type of grant your organisation has received.



## For all grant in aid recipients

Arts Council of Wales is a Welsh Government Sponsored Body. For organisations that receive funding from our grant in aid, the Arts Council of Wales logo should therefore be accompanied by the Welsh Government logo at all times. The combined logo strip can be positioned where most practical and should always be used in its true form.

The full colour version of the logo strip should be used wherever possible. The black or white versions may only be used where cost is an issue, for example, one-colour print runs, or where legibility would be an issue.

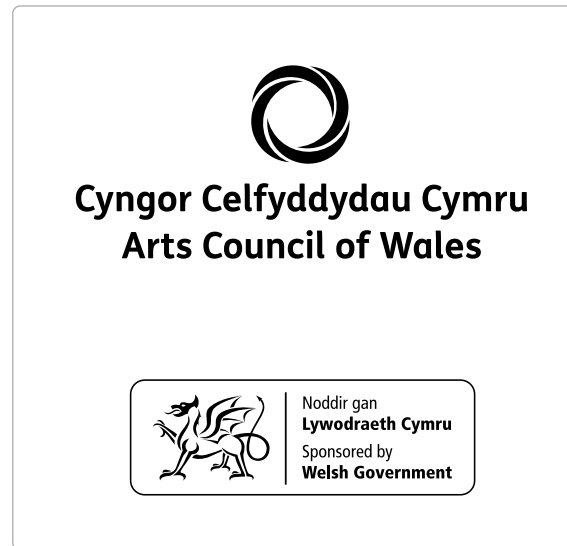

## For lottery grant recipients

Arts Council of Wales lottery funding should be acknowledged by displaying the National Lottery logo on all publicity material alongside the Arts Council of Wales and the Welsh Government logos.

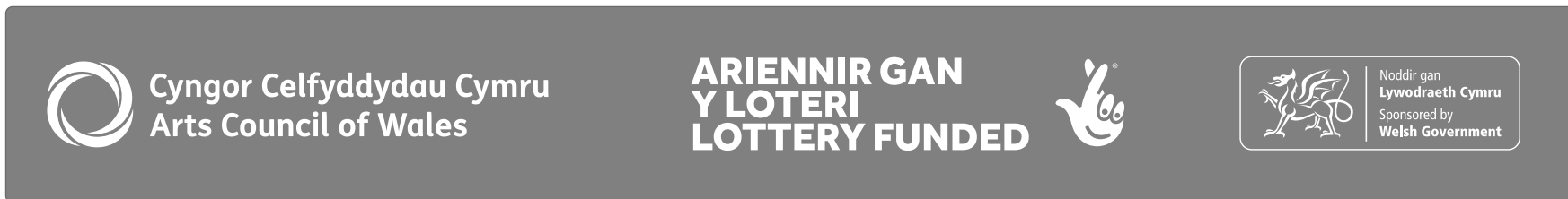

## For Lottery Grant recipients, including recipients of the International Opportunities Fund

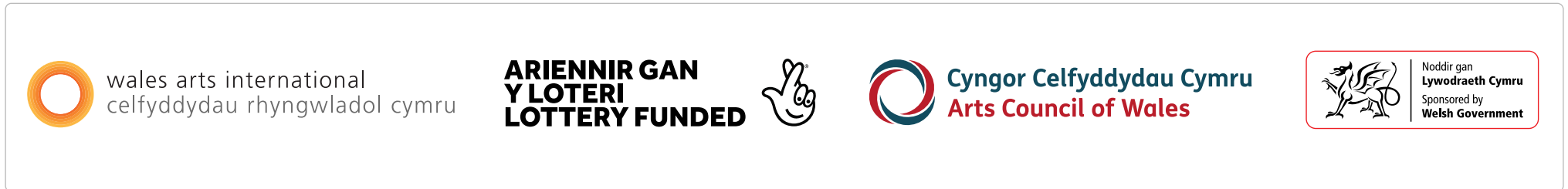

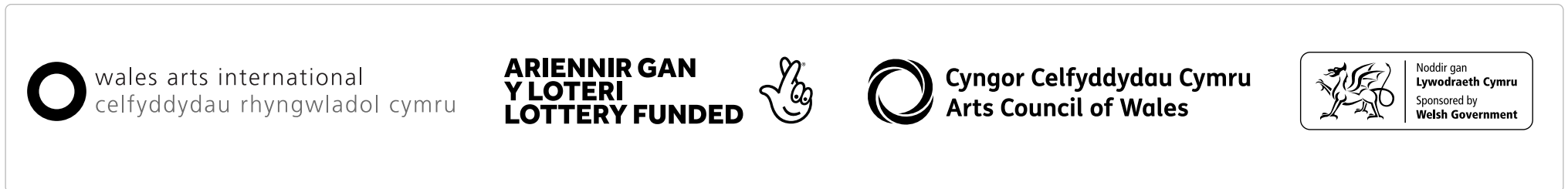

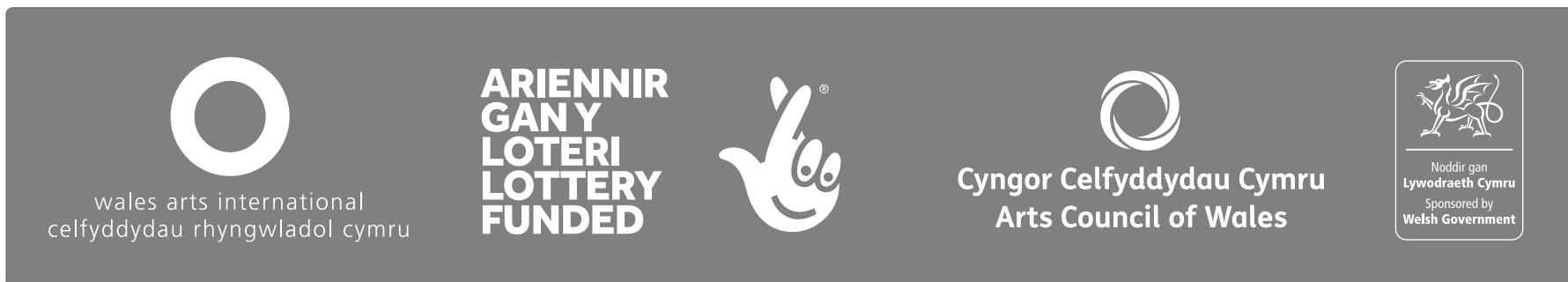
